

Exam and scholarship agreement

Regulation for the awarding of a scholarship "Mario Sanna "
For the collaboration of the Research Activities from 2017 on

Art.1 Subject

1. This Regulation regulates the awarding of 1 grant for cooperation in research activities assigned by the Gruppo Otologico following public selections and on the basis of resources allocated for the year 2016, in accordance with the objectives of the Gruppo Otologico.
2. The grant awarded by the GO is assigned to specialized doctors in ENT (Otolaryngology) in the years 2017 on and with an age not exceeding 40 years, who holds a degree in medicine recognized nationally or internationally by the law.
3. The scholarship is awarded in order to provide the physician with expertise can contribute to the GO scientific program in accordance with the guidelines set out by the Gruppo Otologico.
4. The purpose of the Mario Sanna scholarship is described here in favor of doctors who, under equal conditions and compliance with institutional goals, will result more talented.

Art.2 Requirements for participation in the selection

1. Participation in the selections for the Mario Sanna scholarship are all medical graduates, and later specialized in ENT in every recognized university of the world, who are under 40 years of age at the date of the final exam.
2. In addition to the subjects mentioned in the preceding paragraph may participate in foreign specialized doctors in possession of equivalent qualifications and appropriate scientific curriculum activity of planned research.

Art.3 Submission of requests to participate

1. Applications for participation in the selection, drafted with clear layout, should be addressed to the Gruppo Otologico with paper or electronic mail no later than _____.
2. The application form must contain:
Curriculum Vitae with addresses and contacts of candidate, qualifications, publications and scientific breakthrough activities, courses, seminars, workshops if certificates, certificates of foreign languages if they have, in PDF format or any office-like readable format.
b. Statement of willingness to attend at the time and manner prescribed by the announcement in PDF format
c. These Regulations signed and scanned in PDF format

Art.4 Admission of Candidates

1. The administration of the Gruppo Otologico shall receive requests to participate sent in a single mail or email and shall promptly inform the admission of the candidate by e-mail if the candidate was eligible, that meets the submission requirements.
2. The exclusion of a candidate not eligible is final. If there are irregularities or concerns the eligibility you are asked any subsequent additions to the dead line for submission of applications.

Article 5. Criteria for the selection of candidates

1. Candidates eligible to participate in the selection, they will be judged according to their scientific curriculum, quality and relevance of the research project, corresponding to the Gruppo Otologico goals and an examination in writing and orally, to the following criteria:

Correspondence of the candidate qualities to the scientific aim of the Gruppo Otologico	15%	from 0 to 10
Exam (on line or written)	40%	from 0 to 10
Live streaming interview	20 %	from 0 to 10

The candidate's rating is a weighted average of the percentage and voting.
The maximum score will be 10.

1. The exam takes place on _____. It is divided into a written test of three hours (09:00 to 12:00) in which the candidate answers to on line questions, and an oral examination in Italian language or English language in which the candidate will discuss the theme of the exam and will be challenged from the judging committee. The themes medical and scientific issues of the test will be as follows:

- a. General otology
- b. Otoneurosurgery
- c. Pathologies of the Cranial Base
- d. Implantology
- e. Hearing aid technology

2. The board of examiners ensures that the candidate has the knowledge and skills needed to be involved in research. The jury's decision is final and not questionable.

3. Applicants who do not show (connect) in the day and time specified will not participate in the examination.

Art.6 Examining Committee

1. The Commission will be nominated by the GO founder prof. Mario Sanna according to principles of strict impartiality. The Commission is made up of himself and two Italian researchers and doctors do not linked to the national education system. The Commission is composed of the Scientific Committee of the MSF. To ensure a more accurate and impartial selection, the Committee makes use of the following surgeons:

to. Dott. Prof. Miguel Arestegui, director of the Otolaryngology Department of the Hospital Gregorio Marañon in Madrid, Spain.

b. Dr. Sampath Chandra Prasad Rao, MSc., A specialist in otoneurosurgery and Skull Base, Manipal University, India

The invited surgeons and medical doctors can carry out their assessment, if unable to attend physically, electronically. An administrative clerk with only the secretary, will follow and will put on record the decisions of the commission.

2. The committee expresses only through numerical vote according to the above criteria and shall draw up the final list no later than _____.

3. The winner, who became a fellow of the scholarship "Mario Sanna", is the candidate with the highest vote numerically.

Article 7 Communication of results

1. The announcement of the results will be announced no later than _____ by e-mail and/or the official web page to all participants examined. They will be published only the first three candidates. If the candidate wants to know their vote, it may require administration via paper or electronic mail.

2. In case of renunciation of the winner, a decision to grant the scholarship to the next candidate on the list.

Art.8 collaboration ratio

1. The Mario Sanna scholarship is conferred by private contract by the Gruppo Otologico to the candidate identified as the winner by the Commission.

2. The contract does not constitute in any way an employment relationship and does not give rise to rights of access in any business, organization or foundation.

Art.9 Obligations and duties of the fellow

1. The holder of the scholarship "Mario Sanna" carries out its activities at the Department of Otology Gruppo Otologico of the nursing home Piacenza S.p.A. with headquarters in Via Morigi 41, 29121, Piacenza (Italy), in the manner determined by the founder Mario Sanna. The fellow will utilize the facilities, equipment and services available in the health facility.

2. Subject to the approval of the founder Mario Sanna, the fellow may perform any services to outside of said housing in a manner to be determined in accordance with the structure and the research program.

3. All data, information, databases, educational and scientific material of which the fellow will own during his stay, shall be considered confidential and therefore is not allowed, nor a use for purposes other than those indicated by the founder Mario Sanna, or the production, appropriation, popularization. Add LEGAL CONSEQUENCES

4. The scholarship holder is obliged to constant presence in the structure of the Gruppo Otologico. Absences are accepted not never justified and in any case exceeding 20 days.

5. The scholarship holder is obliged to behave properly its business and to the host structure. They are provided letters of warning and withdrawal of the scholarship otherwise.

6. Is at the discretion of the Gruppo Otologico the cancellation of the scholarship for reasons of serious default or causes due to unsuitable behavior.

Art.10 Duration and Amount

1. The duration of the scholarship is 12 months, starting on _____ and ending _____ date on which the research collaboration relationship ends. In cases such as maternity or risk serious health reasons, these dates will be re-discussed with the Gruppo Otologico.

2. With respect to risks, accidents or civil liability, or the Gruppo Otologico nor the host health facility are held responsible

3. The candidate is entitled to receive the amount of _____ gross divided into 12 monthly installments from the date of the collaboration BEGINNING, for a net income of _____ if the subject without other income. The pump will be suspended during the period of maternity leave at risk or serious health reasons. Such suspension shall lead to the decay of the rights of the scholarship.

4. The fellow who, having started the business, for whatever reason, can not carry out the activity, it is required to give prompt notice to the administration of the Gruppo Otologico, and loses the right to the structure and attendance at monthly from the previous month to communication.

Art.11 Implementation and evaluation

1. Grant recipients will participate in the activities and projects for which it was selected and the host structure with intake of specific responsibilities and duties in direct collaboration with the medical and administrative staff.

2. The activities and scientific medical programs are agreed with the host structure at the beginning of his training and are defined by a work plan agreed with the workforce, which provides mentoring and reporting of results over time.

3. The fellow is required to prepare a research paper in accordance with the organic to the end of his period of stay. This document is the result of research carried out by the fellow with the staff on the subjects indicated Art.5. This document is not subject to an assessment, however, will be considered valid for possible publication.

Art.12 Privacy policy

1. Personal data sent by applicants to the Gruppo Otologico are processed pursuant to Legislative Decree 196/2003 only for the purposes of the selection of the winner candidate.

2. The provision of such data is necessary for the evaluation of the candidates who apply for participation.
