GENERAL INFORMATION

Since 1985, each year, the Gruppo Otologico and the AINOT (Associazione Italiana Neuro-Otologica) jointly have been organizing Middle Ear and Skull Base Surgery dissection courses. In the last couple of decades these courses have been the most sought after courses in Europe for Middle Ear and Skull Base surgery dissection courses. In the last couple of decades these courses have been the most sought after courses in Europe for Middle Ear and Skull Base dissection surgical dissection training. The objective of these courses is to improve the knowledge of surgical anatomy of the temporal bone and lateral skull base surgeries.

The 5 day courses are held at the Gruppo Otologico institute (Piacenza) and are designed for both beginners and experienced surgeons. Apart from dissections on the temporal bone, participants also have the opportunity to attend lectures on diagnostic and surgical neuroradiology, clinical cases as well as observe live and recorded surgical sessions.

The participants also have the chance to interact with some of the biggest name in the field of Otology, Neurotology, Skull Base Surgery, Neuroradiology who will be invited as faculty at these courses.

PROGRAMME

The focus of the course is to update the participants on the surgical anatomy and surgical procedures in Middle Ear and the lateral Skull Base. The course is scheduled on weekdays from Monday to Friday and is organized in two sessions morning and afternoon.

MORNING

This session includes: surgical anatomy and surgical videos, live surgeries (9 am to 1 pm) with interaction between participants and surgeons in the operating theatre. The entire range of important ear surgeries will be covered.

AFTERNOON

This session includes temporal bone dissections supervised by the course faculty and supervisors. All important procedures will be demonstrated.

MIDDLE EAR COURSE

This course is aimed at refining the participants knowledge of the anatomy of the temporal bone and learning basic and advanced surgeries of the middle ear including the transcanal and transmastoid approaches to the middle ear, open and combined approach tympanoplasty, facial nerve decompression, subtotal petrosectomy, stapes surgery, cochlear implant surgery and the translabyrinthine approach. Two to three fresh temporal bones will be provided to each participant for dissection.

Skull Base Course

This course is aimed at refining the participants knowledge of the anatomy of the lateral Skull Base and learning complex and definitive lateral skull base procedures including the translabyrinthine approaches, the infratemporal fossa approaches (types A, B, C and D), modified transcochlear approach, the petro-occipito-trans-sigmoid approach, the retrosigmoid and the enlarged Middle cranial fossa approaches. Temporal bones and injected full cadaveric head will be provided to each participant for dissection.

USING THE WILLIAM HOUSE DISSECTION LABORATORY AT THE GRUPPO OTOLOGICO

The temporal bone dissection laboratory named after Dr. William House, who was the teacher of Prof. Mario Sanna, is a state-of-the-art faculty set up in the premises of the Gruppo Otologico. It has 20 fully equipped stations, each composed by a Zeiss microscope, Bien-Air drill system (renovated in 2017) centralized suction irrigation, set of surgical instruments and temporal bone holders. The room is well illuminated, ventilated and is equipped with three 30 inch flat screen TVs which enable monitoring of dissections by the tutors and also for displaying teaching videos of surgery and dissection. Over 1000 trainees and fellows from all parts of the globe have been trained here in microsurgery of the Middle Ear and Skull Base in over 160 courses organized over the last 20 years.
